

## Department 45 4-H CLOVER COLLECTION

**Eligibility** – Grades are as of January 1, current year for all 4-H members. Participants may enter only one lot in the Clover Collection Show.

### Judging Procedure

\*Garments must be constructed by the contestant with the exception of Lot 1. All garments in the outfit must be sewn by the 4-H member. This does not include accessories.

\*Appropriate construction methods should be used for member's age and skill level.

\*Judging will be on a grade-level basis with consideration given to the following points:

(The Clover Collection Score Sheet will be used)

- Appearance of Model (20 points)
- Outfit on model (40 points)
- Construction as it affects appearance (30 points)
- Knowledge of subject matter (10 points)

**Premiums are: 1st \$50, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20, and all other credible entries \$10.**

Description should be written before contest begins at least by 11:30 A.M. \*Description should be well-written, complete with a note on any special construction details or fabric choices. (Hint: pattern envelopes can provide assistance.)

## Section 1

### Divisions

Judging will be by grade level cluster. Remember that all garments in the outfit must be constructed by the 4-H member, with the exception of Lot 1.

(1 - 2 years sewing experience)
- Class 3** Accessory 4-5
- Class 4** School Wear Grades 4<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup>
- Class 5** Best Wear Grades 4<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup>
- Class 6** Accessory 6-8
- Class 7** School Wear Grades 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>
- Class 8** Best Wear Grades 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>
- Class 9** Accessory 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>
- Class 10** School Wear Grades 9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>
- Class 11** Best Wear Grades 9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>

**Judging** is based on coordination and selection of ensemble as appropriate for the provided scenario and budget. Also considered will be accessories chosen; appearance of outfit on individual, and modeling ability. Description should be written before the contest begins and ready before 12:00 p.m. Description should include complete outfit including accessories and savings information.

5. Active Sports Wear 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades
6. School Wear 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades
7. Best Wear 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades
8. School Wear 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades
9. Best Wear 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades
10. Formal Wear 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades
